## Duties and responsibilities

- Pick up and drop off passengers at designated locations
- Follow a planned route according to a time schedule
- Help disabled passengers get on and off the bus
- Obey traffic laws and state and federal transit regulations
- Follow procedures to ensure passenger safety
- Perform basic maintenance (check the bus tires, lights and oil)
- Keep the bus clean and presentable to the public
- Keep order and safety on the bus
- Report discipline problems to school district or parents

## Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED
- CDL License or the ability to obtain one
- Excellent communication skills
- Pass a background check

## Physical requirements

- Frequently required to stand, walk, sit, and talk or hear.
- Occasionally required to use hands to touch, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- In case of emergency the employee must be able to lift and/or move more than 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
- Regularly exposed to outside weather conditions.
