WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION CHARTER SCHOOLS PETITION PROCESS

- 1. A letter of intent shall be submitted to the local Board and the Office of Charter School Compliance no later than 6 months in advance of the charter petition being submitted.
- 2. The final charter petition shall be submitted on or before January 1st.
- 3. The local board of education will vote to approve or deny a petition no later than June 30th
- 4. The time frame between when the local board approves the charter petition and when the charter school is expected to begin serving students (the "pre-opening" period) shall be at least 6 months.

If the WCBOE denies a charter petition, it shall within twenty (20) days provide to the charter petitioner and the State Board of Education (SBOE) a written explanation setting forth its reasons for denial and a list of deficiencies in the petition. If the reason for denial includes that approval is not in the public interest, such explanation shall include a detailed explanation as to why. A denial does not prevent a petitioner from resubmitting a revised petition that addresses the deficiencies cited in the denial.

If the WCBOE approves a charter petition, it shall within thirty (30) days provide a copy of the petition it approved to the State Department of Education (SDOE) for review by the SBOE.
